

RECENT SOLOMON ISLANDS POSTAL FORMS

The Solomon Islands Postal Corporation is now using a number of forms for customer service. Of special interest are forms used in their Mail Monitoring Centre in the capital, Honiara. Starting 2 May 2011, Solomon Post instituted this monitoring as a result of customer complaints of delays. The small green form is attached to packets that have been checked or opened (Figure 1). This is dated 4 May 2011, and it is likely a provisional printing.

A newer form is known with the Solomon Post logo and colour scheme (Figure 2) that performs the same purpose as Figure 1.
